Courses will be held on Thursday evenings, from 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. There will be two nights the course will go from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. The course runs eleven weeks, beginning on September 9 and ending with a graduation ceremony on November 15.

## Participation Requirements

1. You must be age 18 or older to apply.
2. Priority will be given to those applicants living or working in the City of Wyoming.
3. A criminal background check will be conducted on all applicants prior to acceptance into the program. Approval must be granted by the Police Chief before applicants will be accepted into the program.
4. Appropriate business attire (business casual) and the provided identification badges are required to be worn during all training activities.
5. Applications will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Class size is limited.
6. Participants are not permitted to carry weapons.
7. Participants must conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times. Failure to comply with academy rules will result in dismissal from the program.
8. To successfully complete the program, participants must attend a minimum of 80% of the scheduled sessions.
9. Incomplete applications will not be processed.
